- **Annual Pass – Participating companies receive a 20% discount on Adult and Family Annual Passes.**
- **Continuous Monthly Pass* – Participating companies enjoy a 20% discount off the Continuous Monthly Membership Program using our convenient Pre-Authorized Debit Program.**
- **Multi Admission Pass – Participating companies receive a 15% discount on our already discounted multi admission pass (starting at 5 visits).**

Employees who purchase the above passes will be issued a photo access card which is to be swiped at each admission.

*Members will be asked to verify their eligibility for the discounted membership on an annual basis.

Failure to do so may result in a suspension of the discounted membership rate until valid documentation is presented.
